Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council Arbitrations

MARBA received no arbitration demands in the month of June.

Laborers Joint Grievance Committee

The Laborers JGC met on June 25 at the Laborers District Council offices in Burr Ridge to hear one grievance. The grievance alleged a contractor violated the CBA by improperly terminating one of its employees. The allegations made by the Grievant claimed an argument was started by the Employer's Superintendent in which the Grievant ultimately feared for their safety. The Employer argued that the Grievant was the aggressor in the incident and they terminated the member due to violations of the Employer's company handbook, overall disregarding safety on the job site. The Grievant and Employer both presented their version of the events and presented evidence to the JGC. After hearing both parties and receiving the evidence, the JGC upheld the grievance and awarded the Grievant backpay. The next JGC is set for July 30, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. at the Laborers offices provided there are any grievances set to go forward.

Operating Engineers Joint Grievance Committee

The Operating Engineers JGC did not meet in June. The next Operating Engineers JGC will be held on July 10, 2024, at the Operating Engineers office in Countryside. There are currently four (4) grievances set to be heard.

Teamsters Joint Grievance Committee

The Teamsters JGC did not meet in June. The next regularly scheduled JGC is set for July 25, 2024, at the MARBA office, provided there are any grievances set to go forward.

Federal Judge Issues Nationwide Injunction on Portions of Davis-Bacon Amendments

A judge in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas issued a nationwide preliminary injunction in a lawsuit filed by the Associated General Contractors of America (AGC) against the Department of Labor for the DOLs expansion of the Davis-Bacon Act (DBA). The AGC argued the DOLs expansion of the DBA, as it pertained to truck drivers and material suppliers owned and operated by GCs and/or subcontractors, was unconstitutional. The AGCs lawsuit also targeted a provision of the DBA that requires the application of DBA to construction contracts when the underlying prime contract makes no reference to the DBA.

In issuing the injunction, the judge stated, "the Defendants engaged in egregious violations of Article II, section 3 of the Constitution, because rather than taking care to faithfully execute the DBA, Defendants instead usurped Congress' law-making power and attempted substantive amendments to the DBA.... Doing so violates the Constitution, and this preliminary injunction shall be issued to prevent this blatantly unlawful action."

The preliminary injunction will remain in effect until and unless it is extinguished (or modified) at a subsequent proceeding. The AGCs initial statement and a link to their petition can be found by clicking here. The District Court's decision can be found by clicking here.
